Important 2012 Conference Changes

All registration forms have changed please use the new forms.

Registration Check in is from 13:00 to 18:00 Thursday at the Double Tree second floor.

The individual scenario "Job Interview" will take place again this year in the Civic Center Riverview Suites. Sign up for the event will be at the registration desk where you also get your team event times. Each post will be guaranteed to include one explorer, but most posts will get to sign up two. This will be based on first come first served basis. Please speak to your explorers ahead of time and select your representatives based on age, experience, and immediate impact of being involved in this scenario. Last year we had 86 explorers interviewed, with the top three recognized at the awards banquet. The interview panel, made up of officers and administrators from throughout the state, have all asked to return because of their positive experience last year.

There will be an academic presentation **Thursday night** regarding the job interview scenario. One of the judges has some suggestions to help all explorers improve their interview skills. Whether they are participating in the event or not. This will not be a tested event and no awards or scholarships will be given. Please check your conference book for time and location.

This year academic sessions are open and more than one team per post can attend. Only one test per post will be allowed. If two tests are found to be submitted both will be disqualified.

All registrations are due by March 1, 2012. Rooms will be released to the general public so we will not be able to guarantee you a room if you register after March 1, 2012. Please send your registration to the correct address so it is not lost or delayed. Please review all paperwork to make sure your registration is not delayed because of errors. Hotel assignments will be based on the date all you paperwork has been turned received.

If you are waiting for money to turn your paper work in please contact DuWayne so the paper work can get entered and you will not be put on the bottom of the list.

Please notify us of any changes so we can keep the hotels informed of the rooms needed for the conference.

There are no limits to the number of explorers and advisors you wish to bring!

You will be notified via e-mail on your housing information and if you **will be sharing rooms**. Your room info will be assigned as the conference date approaches. Please make sure we have an updated e-mail address for your post and it is reviewed on a daily basis.

Please check into your hotel and then come to our registration desk to check in with us and get your Conference information.

Park at your hotel parking lot when you check in, please remember the hotel lots have height restrictions. We have secured some surface lots for large vehicles and trailers. Information will be in the packet and sent if needed, please advise us of your vehicles.

Opening ceremonies will be held Thursday night at 19:00 at the Mayo Center Exhibit Hall. Immediately after, the parade of squads will start.
